

What is the Diaspora?

African Union (AU) Executive Council definition of the African Diaspora:

“The African Diaspora consists of peoples of African origin living outside the continent [of Africa], irrespective of their citizenship and nationality and who are willing to contribute to the development of the Continent and the building of the African Union”. The table below confirms the relatively high presence of the Diaspora in the world:
