Background

- 
- ◆ SANAC is a multi-sectoral national body that enables SANAC meeting of 28 November resolved:
 - All key departments should report on NSP implementation progress
 - Improve men sector proposal
 - Standalone SANAC website should be created
 - Report back on Task shifting should be given by DoH
 - Recommendations on final Treatment guidelines to be given by DoH
 - Progress report on implementation of NSP M & E framework
 - A local meeting of experts should be convened to discuss male circumcision
 - ◆ The PIC report includes a summary of progress made on plenary resolutions and additional

Progress to date

- 
- ◆ PIC is fully operational, and has held 4 meetings since last plenary
 - ◆ All technical task committees established and operational at different levels e.g Presentation relatively weak (fewer meetings)
 - ◆ Government departments and civil society sectors developed implementation plans for the National Strategic Plan for HIV, AIDS and STIs (detailed reports to be given by civil society deputy chair and departments)
 - ◆ Monitoring and Evaluation framework for NSP including reporting template have been finalized
 - In printing
 - TTT Research M & E tasked to develop a plan for sectoral operationalization
 - ◆ 2008 country UNGASS report finalized
 - TTTs tasked with considering programme implications for various task teams

Progress to date

- 
- ◆ The Provincial Councils on AIDS are at different levels of restructuring and activeness
 - ◆ Workshop with PCs held on 26 May 2008 and established a workshop to develop procedural guidelines within 2 months.
 - ◆ A workshop for task shifting to be held within 1 month.
 - ◆ Treatment guidelines were finalized and disseminated to sectors for implementation (detail in DoH presentation)
 - ◆ Male circumcision : a workshop will be convened by the DoH (detailed report to be presented by DoH)
 - ◆ Priority areas identified for Global Fund round 8 application



Progress to date

- ◆ **NunuCom appointed to develop SANAC website**
 - Nunucom specializes in eMarketing, Web, Graphic and Software Design;
 - Process of registering a domain has started - proposed domain name is www.sanac.org.za.
 - On completion of the registration, NunuCom will provide three web stills (non moving layout of the site) to choose the preferred layout (PIC to be consulted) .
 - The interactive SANAC website will provide a high quality, user friendly and reliable application with Voice Navigation for the blind and , Text Zoom capability for the visually impaired ready for testing July
